



- People want to work







What is Equity?



NDC Equity Capital

Program Snap Shot

- Public Equity
- Unanimous Shareholder Agreement
- Investment period between 5 and 10 years
- Investment amount between \$250,000 and \$500,000
- Dividend varies and is project / risk dependent
- No Penalty for early remdemption of shares
