



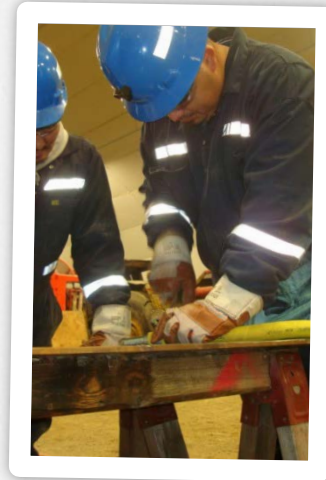

- o Select good candidates through proper screening
- o Cost share training expenditures.
- o Deliver in-house training on site and in community
- o Provide mentoring throughout the training and employment.

Accomplishments

- o 47 full-time, casual & seasonal workers
- o 56% from Rankin, 44% from other Kivalliq communities.
- o 95% Inuit workforce, 25-100% Inuit content on site.
- o 12% women
- o 31% working in town, 69% employed on site
